Creative Cooking *Grades: 1st-3rd*

We will also introduce basic cooking vocabulary and a variety of cooking utensils. Students will enjoy cupcake decorating along with a variety of simple snacks and goodies associated with traditional holidays. We will explore a diversity of foods from various cultures and discover the origin of exotic fruits and vegetables. Most recipes will be pre-cooked, or no-cook recipes. Throughout the course, we will incorporate reading, math, science, religion, health/nutrition, history and social studies.

Keyboarding Lessons

Young children learn high sounds and low sounds & their direction on the keyboard. Students learn proper posture and hand/finger position. They increase muscle control as they learn that varying the weight of their fingers produces softer or louder tones. Children also learn the music alphabet, sequencing, & patterns. Students can recognize bar lines and measures and they learn to identify notes and note values. Keyboard provided during lessons.



Guitar Lessons

Our small group sessions give participants the chance for group interaction as well as individualized attention for growth of specific skills. With Tickled Ivories, your child will develop into a complete and self-motivated musician! Enrolling your child in guitar will provide opportunities for fun and learning during critical stages of development.
